

# BOYS GOLF

## Revised: March 2007

### 1.0 DATE

The date shall be set in the WOSSAA calendar and shall be held in the fall.

### 2.0 LOCATION

The location shall be determined by the host Conference. The tournament shall be rotated as per the rotating list of conveners. For the next five (5) years, (beginning in 2004), TVRAA will host the boys tournament at the St. Thomas GCC (Union).

### 3.0 TOURNAMENT STRUCTURE AND PROCEDURES

3.1 A one day 18 hole tournament is to be held.

3.2 All WOSSAA schools are eligible to compete.

3.3 Each team will consist of four players.

3.4 Huron Perth - 4 teams (4 players) + coaches = 20  
- 2 low individuals + coaches = 4  
= 24 total

TVRAA Central (London) - 7 teams (4) + coaches = 35  
- 2 low individuals + coaches = 4  
= 39 total

TVRAA ( TriCounty ) - 7 teams (4) + coaches = 35  
- 2 low individuals + coaches = 4  
= 39 total

Total number on the course = 102

### 4.0 ENTRY AND ENTRY FEES

4.1 Entries are to be made by the Conference convenor.

4.2 Entry fees are to be established by the convenor, to cover known cost of the tournament.

4.3 Entry fees are to be paid to the convenor before the competition begins. Your team or individual player cannot play before entry fees are paid.

### 5.0 ELIGIBILITY

5.1 All competitors must be eligible according to ByLaw 2 of the WOSSAA Constitution.

## **6.0 RULES AND OFFICIALS**

**6.1** The rules of competition shall be those contained in the WOSSAA Constitution.

**6.2** The rules of golf according to the O.G.A. will be followed as well as any local rules of the hosting club.

## **7.0 SCORING**

**7.1** The team championship shall be determined by the aggregate score of the low 3 scores of the 4 players on each team.

**7.2** In the event of a tie, it shall be resolved by all team members playing a one hole play-off with the winners determined by the lowest aggregate score. If a second play-off is necessary, it shall be played.

## **8.0 DRESS**

**8.1** The dress code of the hosting golf course shall be enforce.

## **9.0 AWARDS**

**9.1** A WOSSAA team plaque will be awarded to the first place team.

**9.2** Individual medals shall be awarded to first, second and third place team members.

**9.3** The low gross medallist of the tournament shall receive a medal.
