

BOYS AND GIRLS HOCKEY

1.0 DATE

The WOSSAA Hockey Championships shall be held the week prior to the March Break.

2.0 LOCATION

The location of the Championship shall be determined by that year's WOSSAA Convenor. The Convenorship shall follow a rotation as indicated in the calendar of rotating Convenorships (see Appendix 3).

3.0 TOURNAMENT STRUCTURE & PROCEDURES

3.1 The Championship will be four a team tournament, with two semifinals followed by a bronze medal game and then a gold medal game. All tournament games will be held on the same day.

3.2 The tournament will follow the draw as outlined in Appendix 11.

Bronze medal game	Losers of the Semifinals.
Finals	Semifinal winners.

4.0 ENTRIES AND ENTRY FEES

4.1 Official entry forms are to be sent to each Conference Convenor by the WOSSAA Convenor. The entry forms, accompanied by an eligibility list for each team, are to be submitted to the WOSSAA Convenor no later than five school days prior to the WOSSAA Championship.

4.2 The entry forms(s) must be accompanied by an entry fee. The amount of the entry fee will be set by the Convenor and will be sufficient to cover the fixed costs of the tournament.

5.0 ELIGIBILITY

5.1 Each player must be eligible for competition under the WOSSAA Constitution, ByLaw 2.

5.2 All competitors must be OFSAA eligible to compete at WOSSAA..

6.0 RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 6.1** The rules as set out in the current OFSAA Hockey Playing Regulations shall govern play except as noted below.
- 6.2** All games shall consist of three 15 minute stop time periods. There **MUST** be an intermission and a flood between the 2nd and 3rd periods, or if possible, between each period.
- 6.3** The convener will arrange to provide referees (3 on-ice officials) and minor officials (timekeeper and scorekeeper as well as goal judges if possible).
- 6.4** One (1 minute) timeout will be allowed per team in any playoff game.
- 6.5** Overtime (if needed) would be a 10 minute stop time sudden death period. The sudden death overtime would be played 3 versus 3. A game that remained tied after sudden death overtime would be broken by a 3 player simultaneous shootout. Three shooters and one alternate must be listed on the gamesheet prior to the game. Penalized players may not participate in the shootout. Substitution for an injured or penalized player using the alternate is allowed. If the game remains tied after the three shooters, then a one shooter simultaneous sudden death shootout shall take place using the same three shooters in the same order.

7.0 AWARDS

The championship team will receive a WOSSAA plaque and each member of the winning team, a gold WOSSAA medal (20 maximum plus 1 for the coach and 1 for a manager). Each member of the WOSSAA finalist team will receive a silver WOSSAA medal (20 maximum plus 1 for the coach and 1 for a manager). Each member of the team winning the bronze medal game will receive a bronze medal (20 maximum plus 1 for the coach and 1 for the manager).

8.0 OFSAA ENTRY

- 8.1** The WOSSAA champion will advance to OFSAA.
- 8.2** The WOSSAA Championship team will be responsible for paying their own OFSAA entry fee.
